### **Champagne & Sparkling Wines**

- 62. Ridgeview Cavendish** **39.00**  
A lovely golden straw colour and exceptionally fine bubbles. The nose is full with hints of red fruits bringing depth and complexity to the palate.
- 63. Boschendal Pavilion Rose** **29.00**  
Sensual salmon in colour, offering diverse and complex flavours from red Berries to floral hints
- 66. Prosecco Valdobbiane Casa Rosa** **25.95**  
A fizzy fruit bombshell. Light-weight and gently aromatic, with crisp, delicate and fresh apple flavours
- 67. Dom Perignon** **190.00**  
More than strength or richness, there is an intensity, a sensation replete with freshness and firmness, which is remarkable
- 68. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label** **57.00**  
This wine is quite simply dazzling with its wealth of aromas, and a delicious long and powerful finish.
- 69. Laurent Perrier Rose NV** **87.00**  
Made using only pinot noir fruit from grand cru village, with delicious raspberry & redcurrant fruit flavour
- 70. House Champagne** **37.00**  
Champagne Fluteau, Carte Blanche Brut Made from 100% Pinot Noir this is fruity Champagne that still manages to be crisply elegant.

### **White Wines**

- 15. Pouilly –Vizelles Louis Latour.** **29.50**  
The nose is floral with a lot of freshness. The generous mouth reveals aromas of white flowers and fresh hazelnuts.
- 16. Macon Lugny, Louis Latour** **27.00**  
Pleasant aromas of mirabelle plums are revealed on the nose and in the mouth. This wine is rich with a long finish
- 17. Chablis Charles Vienot** **30.50**  
A dry crisp taste which distinguishes it from more opulent chardonnays'
- 20. Muscadet Chateau du Cleray Sur Lie** **24.50**  
Dry, crisp white wine with fresh lemon flavours and a zesty character
- 24. Kleinkloof Sauvignon Blanc** **28.50**  
A hint of ripe gooseberry, green apple and citrus has an uplifting intensity.
- 25. Rag & Bone Riesling Australia** **23.50**  
Just a cracking Eden Vally Riesling. Dry textural, limey everything you want from an Aussie Riesling. It finishes lean, fresh linear, crisp.
- 32. Boschendal Grand Cuvee Sauvignon Blanc. South Africa** **31.00**  
These complex flavours carry through to the creamy, harmonious palate adding to the mineral zesty finish.
- 37. Pacifico Sur Reserva Chardonnay Chile** **24.00**  
Crisp fresh lemon aromas with a touch of tropical fruit in the background. Mango and Peach. Complex layer of Kiwi, Apricot and Grassy Tones are present, with a good weight and fantastic balancing zippy acidity.
- 38. Cune Monopole Bianco. Spain** **25.50**  
This unoaked Viura is bright straw yellow with hints of green, followed by aromas of fine citrus and floral, and a touch of grapefruit and orange blossom. The palate shows ripe citrus and mango flavours and a balanced acidity.



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<b>39. Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand</b>	<b>24.50</b>
Zesty and aromatic with lots of lively fruit characters.	
<b>45. Campania Falanghina. Italy</b>	<b>30.00</b>
Light pine scent, but is better known for its citrus-blossom aromas, in particular bitter orange. On the palate it typically shows classic apple and pear flavors.	
<b>46. Greco Di Tufo. Italy</b>	<b>36.00</b>
The refreshing, crisp white wine with aromatic notes of lemons, pears and toasted almonds and a lingering mineral finish.	
<b>47. Frascati Superiore Fontana Candida. Italy</b>	<b>25.00</b>
A light, tasty wine with a dry, crisp finish that's built on a zesty citrus backbone.	
<b>52. Gewurztraminer Reserve, Turckheim.</b>	<b>30.00</b>
A Gewurztraminer wine of great finesse, ripeness and varietal purity, with fragrant rose-petal and grapefruit aromas	

### Red Wines

<b>1. Château Lucas Lussac Saint Emilion</b>	<b>34.00</b>
Lots of fruit from the plummy Merlot to blackberry from the Cabernet and a hint of dark chocolate on the nose.	
<b>2. Château Hanteillan</b>	<b>37.50</b>
Classic aromas of cassis and blackcurrant with just enough toasty oak. Firm tannic grip on palate of this full-bodied, balanced red wine blend.	
<b>3. Croix De Margaux.</b>	<b>43.00</b>
On the nose, straightforward dark fruit with some oak followed by toasty notes. The taste is very fruit-forward and fairly concentrated on the palate. Pleasant and not too overpowering tannins despite the relative youth of this wine.	
<b>4. Cotes De Beaune Villages Louis Latour.</b>	<b>33.00</b>
Ruby red colour with garnet-red lights. On the nose, there are aromas of red berries, blackcurrant and strawberry. The mouth is ample with grilled and undergrowth notes and the tannins are present.	
<b>5. Château Marsan Bordeaux Superieur</b>	<b>35.00</b>
An excellent value Bordeaux, the wine offers rich red fruit on a palate that is supple and round. The silky tannins blend easily with the fruit character and pairs beautifully with dishes like braised lamb or rosemary steak.	
<b>8. Cotes Du Rhone, Leon Perdigal Ogier</b>	<b>24.00</b>
The wine displays plenty of rich ripe fruit whilst retaining a good balance.	
<b>9. Châteauneuf Du-Pape Reine Jeanne Ogier</b>	<b>40.00</b>
Deep ruby purple colour and a sweet nose of ripe Grenache along with raspberries, cherries, liquorice	
<b>10. Bourgogne Gamay Louis Latour</b>	<b>29.00</b>
Shimmering garnet-red in colour and reveals aromas of violet and quince. It is tasty, round and rich with wild strawberry flavours.	
<b>11. Oratorio Crozes Hermitage</b>	<b>52.00</b>
Immediate frankness and freshness in the mouth with very fine tannins. A perfect lively finish and the complexity on the nose.	
<b>12. Fleurie Charles Vienot</b>	<b>31.00</b>
This is beautifully refreshing and irresistibly moreish modern Beaujolais	
<b>26. McGuigan Signature Shiraz</b>	<b>25.00</b>
Rich dark red in colour with a wonderful bouquet of ripe plum and berry fruits	



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<b>29. Tempus Two Merlot Sliver Series</b>	<b>25.00</b>
Voluptuous in the mouth, the tannins are plentiful but soft. The fruit is plump, and tinged in spicy oak.	
<b>30. Malbec France</b>	<b>24.00</b>
A young red fruit on the nose with a structured palate of floral hits, plum and berries.	
<b>31. Rickety Bridge Shiraz</b>	<b>32.00</b>
Layered with redcurrants and mulberry and subtle hints of spice and white pepper, this wine displays elegance and structure on the palate along with fine supple tannins.	
<b>33. Boschendal Lanoy Cabernet Merlot. South Africa</b>	<b>31.00</b>
A rich, smooth wine with flavours of blackberry, chocolate and spice.	
<b>36. Etchart Privado Malbec Argentina</b>	<b>24.00</b>
A rich, yet very soft example of what many regard as Argentina's most successful red grape.	
<b>40. Oyster Bay Merlot. New Zealand</b>	<b>24.50</b>
Glorious flavours of juicy black plum, sweet berry fruits and spice	
<b>42. Della Valpolicella Amarone. Italy</b>	<b>46.00</b>
Brilliant and intense ruby red. Complex and rounded, with a powerful structure supporting the fruit and a lovely freshness on the finish.	
<b>43. Chanti Classico. Italy</b>	<b>24.00</b>
Characteristic Chianti flavours of red cherry and bramble. A fruity wine with a rich finish.	
<b>49. Cune Rioja Tinto Crianza. Spain</b>	<b>28.00</b>
The palate shows some spicy notes and balanced acidity lead to a nicely savoury finish	
<b>50. Marques de Caceres Rioja. Spain</b>	<b>29.00</b>
Redefined bouquet of black cherries and blackberries with a soft touch of aromatic Mediterranean herbs.	

### **Rose Wines**

<b>28. Sutter home White Zinfandel. America</b>	<b>22.50</b>
A delicate blush pink colour introduces this fresh, lively wine. On your palate, light creaminess surrenders to a refreshing crisp finish of strawberries and melon	
<b>51. Cotes De Provence Rose Gassier Sables D'Azur</b>	<b>25.50</b>
Clean, yet full of the fragrance of fresh fruit. Ends on slightly sharp note, which emphasizes its length.	
<b>52. Cabernet Franc Rose</b>	<b>24.00</b>
Cherries, raspberries and strawberries fill the palate whilst the acidity keeps it fresh and on the drier side.	
<b>53. Rose De La Chevaliere</b>	<b>25.00</b>
Pale rose colour with purple hue. Freshly crushed red fruit aromas on the nose. On the palate, flavours of raspberry and redberry combined with fresh acid and lively mouth feel.	

### **Desert Wine**

<b>07. Boschendal Vin 'Or</b>	<b>21.50</b>
Tropical pineapple, green apple and raw honey flavours, supported by vanilla spice from fermentation in oak barrels
